Bogor is an important centre for biodiversity research in Indonesia and home to the biological institutes of the Indonesian Institute of Sciences (LIPI). It is also a major tourist destination, its Botanical Garden enjoys worldwide fame. At a distance of just little over one hour from Indonesia's main air hub in Jakarta, Bogor is conveniently accessible from international destinations. Indonesia is home to two ancient lake systems on the island of Sulawesi, two flight hours from Jakarta. We will offer an optional three day post-conference excursion to one of these ancient lake systems.
